Children, grandchildren and dependents of all active and retired Maple Grove Firefighters and Maple Grove Police Officers as well as Maple Grove Fire and Police Explorers who are accepted to attend an accredited post-secondary institution full-time and pursue any course of undergraduate study.

Scholarship Amounts

Amounts granted up to \$1000 per year per student with up to a total of \$10,000 awarded each year.

Scholarship Selection Criteria

- Academic record
- Demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities
- Work and volunteer experience
- Statement of why you want to further your education
- Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-or four-year college or university for the entire upcoming academic year.
- All majors are eligible for the award.
- Applicants must be high school seniors or college students, up to the age of 24 (or up to age 30 if served in the military)
- Current college freshmen, sophomores and juniors are eligible to apply

An independent committee through MGFRA evaluates the applications and determines the recipients. Family members of applicants are not involved in the selection process.
